The Mecklenburg Declaration, with the names of the Delegates composing the meeting; 2. The certificates testifying to the circumstances attending the Declaration; and 3. The proceedings of the Cumberland Association. In the discharge of this duty, the Governor has deemed it proper to prefix to the publication the following brief review of the evidence by which the authenticity of this interesting portion of the history of North Carolina is controverted and sustained. On the 30th of April, 1819, the publication marked A, made its appearance in the Raleigh Register. It was communicated to the Editors of that paper by Doct. Joseph M Nitt.
