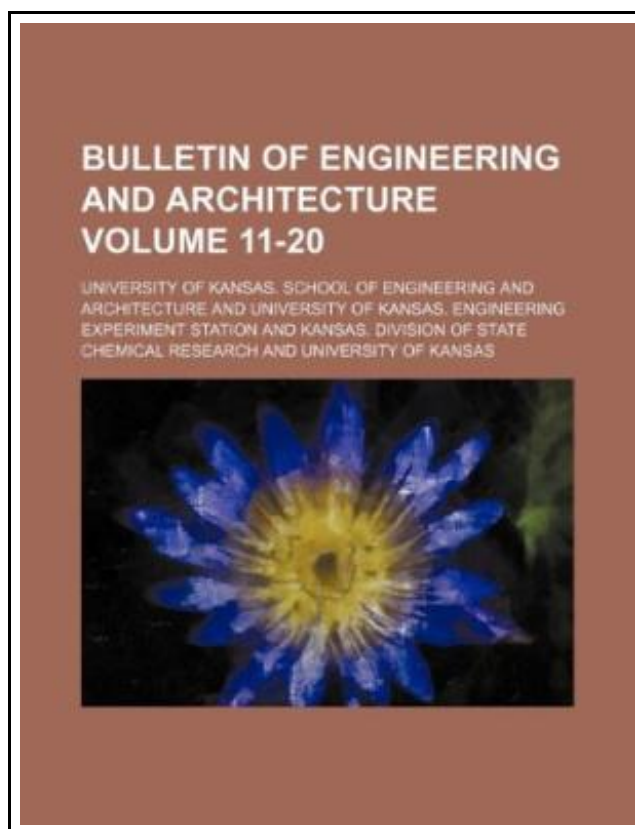

Because of lack of good surface water, shovels are supplied from deep wells, ranging from 760 to about 1,000 feet in depth. Not only is there some difficulty in obtaining good water, but there is expense in keeping the shovels constantly supplied. There must be a well pump to lift the water and a pressure pump to force it through the pipe line to the shovel, as well as a supply tank near the well. While the coal supply offers no difficulty, as the coal is merely taken up from the uncovered bed whenever it is needed, some labor is necessary for coaling the shovel. With one exception, all of the large shovels used in this district are operated by steam, the Pittsburg and Midway Coal Mining Company having one electric shovel, a Bucyrus 225-B.
